MAKING A TITLE VI COMPLAINT

Any person who believes he/she has been subjected to discrimination in the delivery of or access to public transportation services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, may file a complaint with Scottsville Transit (SCOT). Such a complaint must be filed in writing with SCOT no later than 180 days after the alleged discrimination. For information on how to file a complaint, contact (SCOT) as listed below.
